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En musicalisk skattkista

Vår upptäcktsfärd börjar med de unika bronslurarna från 700-talet f Kr – med musik som inte finns. Man har hittat instrument och ljudredskap från forntiden, men ingen musik. Först från medeltiden när munkar och nunnor började teckna ner kyrkans melodier, finns musik bevarad till vår tid. Med Vasakungarna och renässansen under 1500-talet började på allvar vårt utbyte med kontinenten. Och 1600-talets stormaktstid innebar att vi blev delaktiga i en nordeuropeisk musikkultur – tonsättare, musiker och ensembler reste mellan den tidens metropoler kring Östersjön.

Vid den tiden skrevs de första konsertstyckena med svensk sångtext. Men först ett sekel senare lyckades ”den svenska musikens fader” Johan Helmich Roman (1694–1758) visa att svenska språket var ”böjeligt” till musik. Roman var en lysande tonsättare och omsorgsfull konsertarrangör, något som beredde marken för en musicalisk glansperiod, den gustavianska epoken. Då skapades de första operorna på svenska med musik av invandrade tonsättare som J G Naumann, J M Kraus och J C F Haeffner.

1800-talet var framförallt sångens århundrade. Mansköer i Uppsala och Lund och sångare som Jenny Lind inspirerade till en ny blomstringstid i slutet av seklet, då romanskonerterna nådde internationella höjder hos tonsättare som Emil Sjögren, Wilhelm Peterson-Berger, Wilhelm Stenhammar och senare Ture Rangström och Gösta Nystroem. Däremot dröjde det innan den svenska symfonin fann sina former. Den originelle och universelle Franz Berwald, vår främste symfoniker under 1800-talet, flankerad av Adolf Fredrik Lindblad och Ludvig Norman, senare följd av Hugo Alfvén och Wilhelm Stenhammar. Nyklassicister och modernistiska pionjärer som Edvin Kallstenius, Hilding Rosenberg och Moses Pergament beredde under 1900-talets början vägen för det slutgiltiga genombrottet för den central-europeiska modernismen.

Den svenska musikens skattkista innehåller också en rikedom av folkmusik, där de olika landskapen utvecklat sina egena särdrag. Musiken har alltid spelat en viktig roll i det dagliga livet, i arbetet vid fäbodvallen, vid järnvägsbygget och till sjöss. Folkmusiken har också varit en rik inspirationskälla för såväl konstmusikens tonsättare som vår tids jazzmusiker.

A Treasury of Swedish Music

Our voyage of discovery begins with the unique bronze lurz dating from 700 BC – music which does not exist. Music Archaeologists have found instruments and sound implements, but no music. The first music to have been preserved down to our times dates from the Middle Ages, when Church melodies began to be put down in writing. The interchange between Sweden and the Continent of Europe started in earnest with the Vasa monarchs and Renaissance courts of the 16th century. And with the onset of the “Age of Greatness” in the 17th century, Sweden became part of the northern European musical culture, in which composers, musicians and groups toured the metropolitan cities round the Baltic seaboard.

The first concert piece with Swedish words was written at this time. But it was not until a century later that Johan Helmich Roman, “the Father of Swedish Music” proved Swedish to be a language “inclinable” to music. Roman was an eminent composer and concert arranger, which in turn prepared the ground for the brilliant achievements of the Gustavian epoch, when the first operas in Swedish were set to music by immigrant composers like J.G. Naumann, J.M. Kraus and J.C.F. Haeffner.

The 1800s were pre-eminently a vocal century. Male voice choirs in Uppsala and Lund and singers like Jenny Lind inspired a new upsurge during the closing years of the century, with Lieder-writing achieving new international peaks of excellence in the hands of composers like Emil Sjögren, Wilhelm Peterson-Berger, Wilhelm Stenhammar and later Ture Rangström and Gösta Nystroem. The Swedish symphony, by contrast, was some time getting into its stride. The original and universal Franz Berwald, the country’s main symphonic composer of the 19th century, is flanked by Adolf Fredrik Lindblad and Ludvig Norman, followed later by Hugo Alfvén and Wilhelm Stenhammar. In the early 20th century neo-classicists and modernistic pioneers such as Edvin Kallstenius, Hilding Rosenberg and Moses Pergament prepared the ground for the final breakthrough of Central European modernism.

The treasury of Swedish music also contains a wealth of folk music where the provinces have developed their own characteristics. Music has always been an important part of every day life, whether it be working on the farm pasture, building the railways, or at sea. Folk music has been a rich source of inspiration for classical composers as well as today's jazz musicians. Find the many wonders in the treasury of Swedish music!
